Letters of interest should be submitted to the City Clerk's office located at 425 South Lexington Avenue, or mailed to City Clerk Renee Ward at P.O. Box 1358, Burlington, NC 27216. Letters will be accepted until 4:00pm on October 17, 2014.

Letters of interest will be reviewed by the remaining City Council members. Finalist will be selected to appear personally at a City Council Work Session for an interview. Council will then vote to select the next Council member.

The term of the vacant seat will expire in December of 2015.
