1. To establish stop signs at the following locations in Brassfield Meadows Phase 1A
 - On Austin Street at Glenn Street
 - On Glenn Street at Brassfield Drive
 - On Tundra Drive at Brassfield Drive
 - On Thicket Drive at Tundra Drive
 - On Grassland Court at Thicket Drive
 - On Thicket Drive at Plains Drive
 - On Brassfield Drive at Plains Drive
 - On Harris Drive at Plains Drive
 - On Prairie Court at Plains Drive
 - On Plains Drive at Glenn Court
