About VIRTUAL LEARNING REC DAYS

In response to ABSS decision to follow Plan C (Virtual Learning) for the first nine weeks of school, Burlington Recreation and Parks will offer Virtual Learning Rec Days for students enrolled in Alamance-Burlington School System for rising kindergarten through 8th grade. The program will operate at Thataways Youth Center (1331 Overbrook Road, Burlington, NC 27215). This facility will be CLOSED to the non-participants during program hours.

BRPD will provide a quality academic environment (quiet space, socially distanced student work spaces, internet access, adults to monitor etc.) where students can complete their studies. Staff will provide assistance to students as needed but please keep in mind that staff are not teachers. Due to the variance in each students virtual schedule and to reduce distractions, children are required to bring their school work daily. Parents will be asked to submit their student's daily school schedule and login details. Students will be required to provide their own laptops, chargers and headphones. Cellphones will not be allowed.

How to Register

City of Burlington employees will be given priority registration. Due to the Burlington Recreation and Parks Main Office remaining closed, we will hold in person registration on Wednesday, August 19 (City of Burlington employees only) from 12:00-4:00pm. After this date, registration will open to the community. Spaces are limited to 30 students and will be enrolled on a first come, first served basis. Registration forms must be received at the time of registration. **To be eligible:** 1) the child must currently attend kindergarten AND 2) be 5 years on or before August 31, 2020 AND 3) attend school in the Alamance-Burlington School System.

- City of Burlington employees can register Wednesday, August 19 from 12:00-4:00pm at the BRPD Main Office (1333 Overbrook Rd., Burlington, NC 27215).
- As space allows, registration will open to the public on Thursday, August 20 from 8:30am - 1:00pm. and Friday, August 21 from 12:00 - 4:00pm at the BRPD Main Office (1333 Overbrook Rd., Burlington, NC 27215).
- *Those enrolling from the public must be a Burlington city resident.*
- Currently, we are only accepting students from the Alamance-Burlington School System.

Health & Safety Precautions

- Students will be placed into groups of 10 based on their age and/or grade and will remain in these groups for the duration of the program to prevent intermingling.
- We will have designated supplies for each student to use during the week, so they will not be sharing communal school supplies.
- Games and activities will be structured to enforce social distancing measures.
- Cleaning and sanitation practices will be increased. We will have staff with the designated responsibility to clean and sanitize throughout the day.
- Based on the recommendations from the CDC, cloth face masks will be worn by students and staff during indoor activities when maintaining 6 feet is not feasible. We will supply students with masks.
- We will be doing a temperature and health screening for students and staff daily. Students will have their temperatures checked upon arrival and during lunch. If any student or staff displays a temperature of 100.4 or higher, they will not be permitted to remain at the site.
- If a student develops symptoms during the day, they will be isolated and will have to be picked up immediately. Students will be excluded from the program until they can answer YES to ALL the following questions (per NCDHHS):
 - Has it been at least 10 days since you first had symptoms?
 - Have you been without fever for three days (72 hours) without any medicine or fever?
 - Has it been three days (72 hours) since your symptoms have improved?
- We will be limiting the number of individuals allowed at into the site. Therefore, we have developed a drive thru pick-up and drop-off procedure for students. Temperature and health checks will be conducted before the student can enter the site. Each family member will be given a car placard with their student(s) name to be called during pick up. We will still require adults to show their IDs before they can take a student home (names must be on the registration form).
 - We will place designated staff outside at drop off, from 7:30-8:30am, and pick up, from 5:00-6:00pm. If assistance is needed outside of these times, please call the Thataways phone or inform the site director in advance.
- We will have increased hand sanitizer stations and designated hand-washing times. All students will be expected to practice proper hand-washing techniques.
- During meals and snacks, all students will be socially distanced from one another.
- Lunch will be provided by ABSS Feeding Program for all students. We will also provide an afternoon snack. You may choose to send your student with their own lunch. Please ensure your student comes with a water bottle daily (water fountains will not be used.)
- If your student displays behaviors that are not conducive to social distancing measures, we reserve the right to suspend them from the program. Please see the refund policy.
- **Any scenario in which many people gather together poses a risk for COVID-19 transmission. Burlington Recreation & Parks will follow guidelines published by the CDC and NCDHHS to minimize the opportunity for COVID-19 transmission, however, families must recognize that it is currently impossible to eliminate all risk of transmission when participating in activities outside of the home.**
 - *Before your student can attend, parents will be asked to provide a signed copy of The City of Burlington's Liability Waiver Release for Communicable Diseases (found on the website).*

Refund Policy & Late Fee

Refunds will not be issued. In the event of a incident related to COVID-19, refunds will be issued on a situational basis. In the event of a suspension, refunds will not be given.

Parents that are late picking up their student will be charged a late fee of \$1 per minute per family. The Late Fee must be paid before your student can return. If you are consistently late, your student will be dropped from the program.

What to Bring

- Sturdy sneakers & Socks (no flip flops, sandals or crocs)
- Coats as the seasons change (we play outside!)
- Clothes you do not mind getting dirt or paint on throughout the active day
- Laptops, hot-spots, headphones and chargers (**no cellphones**)
- Academic Work and login information

BRPD is not responsible for any items brought from home. Participants are responsible for their belongings brought to Rec Days. Electronics are NOT allowed to be brought to Rec Days, including hand held games, iPods, & cell phones.
