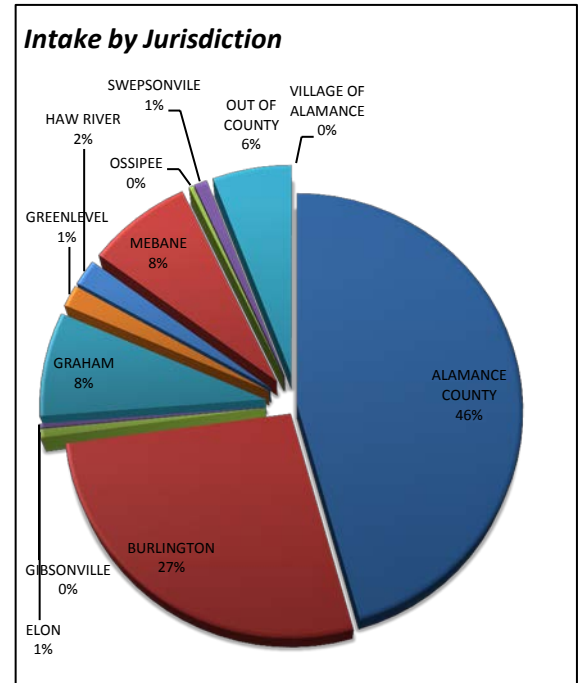

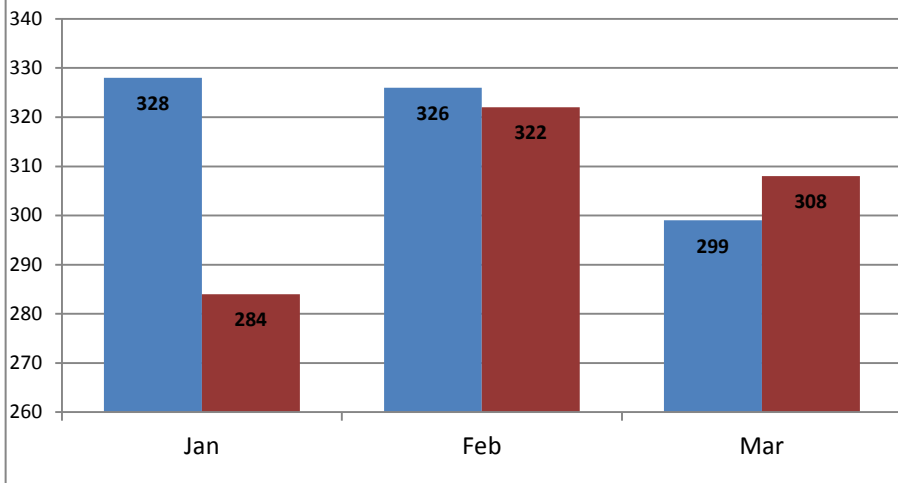

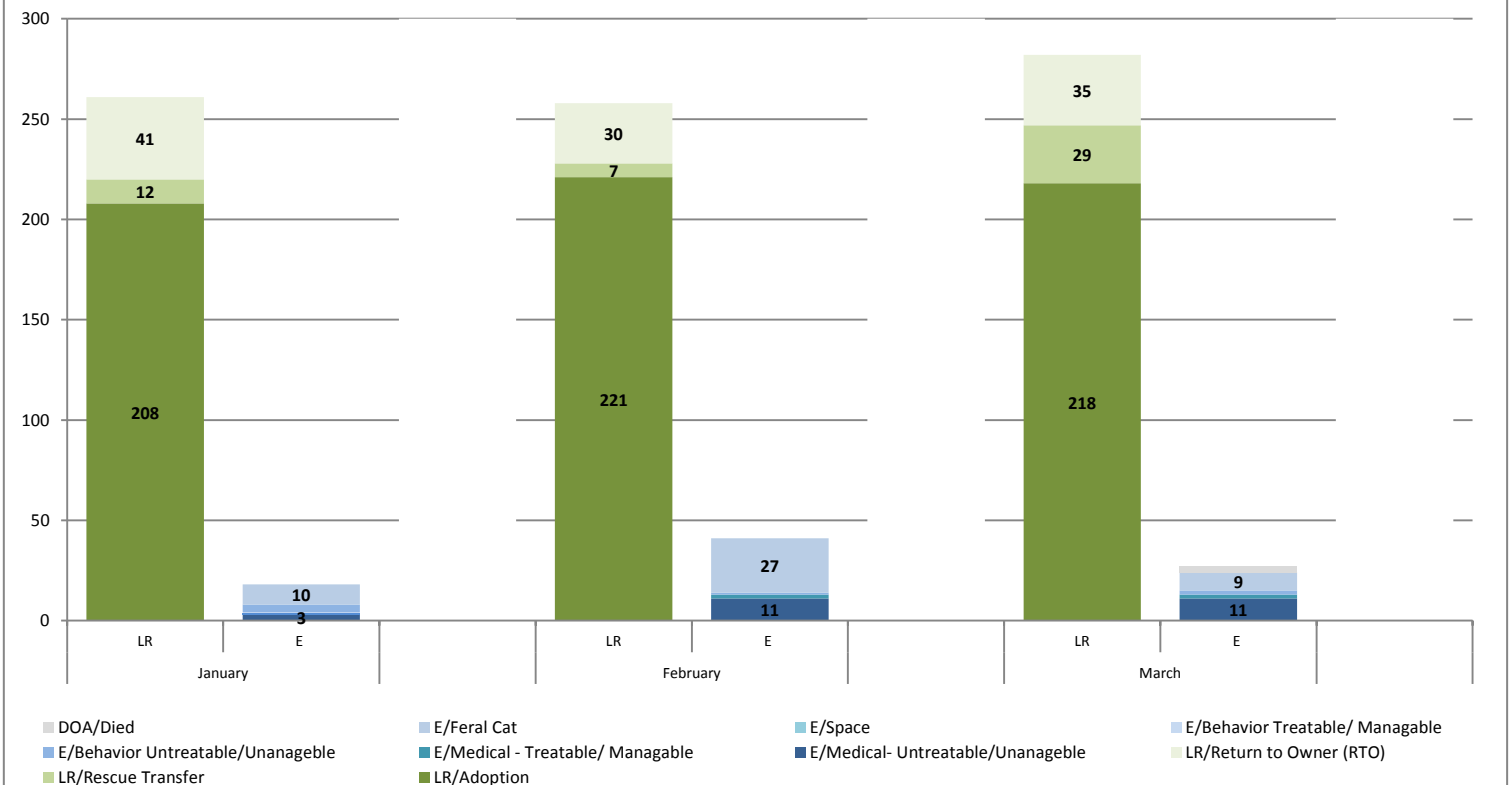

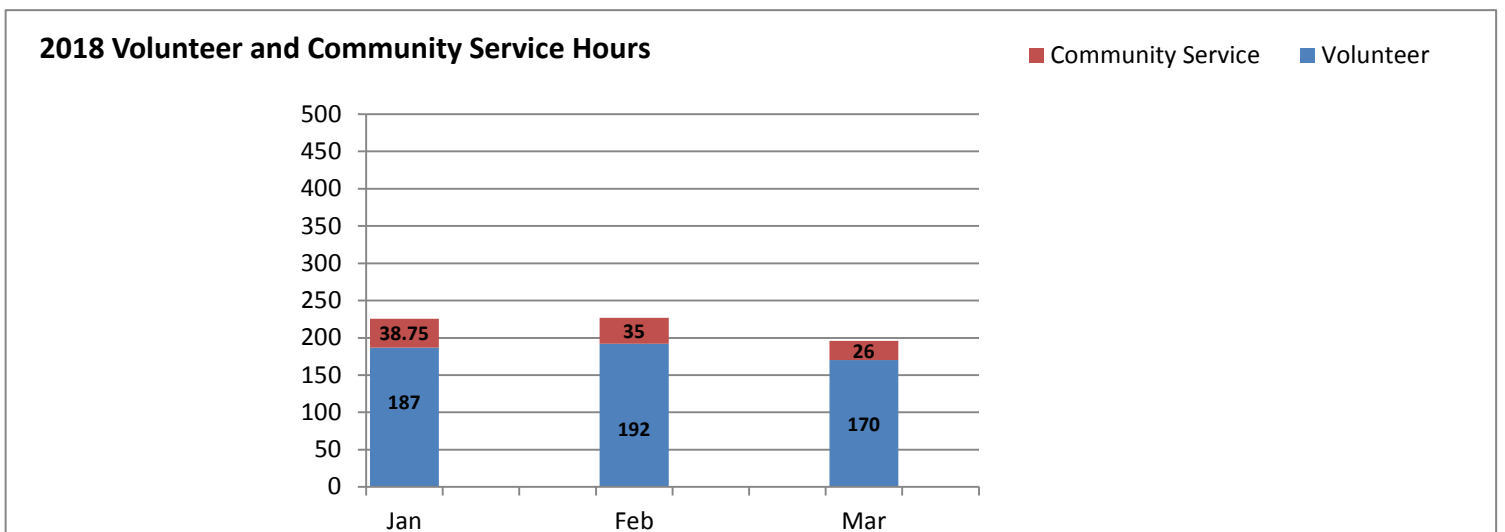

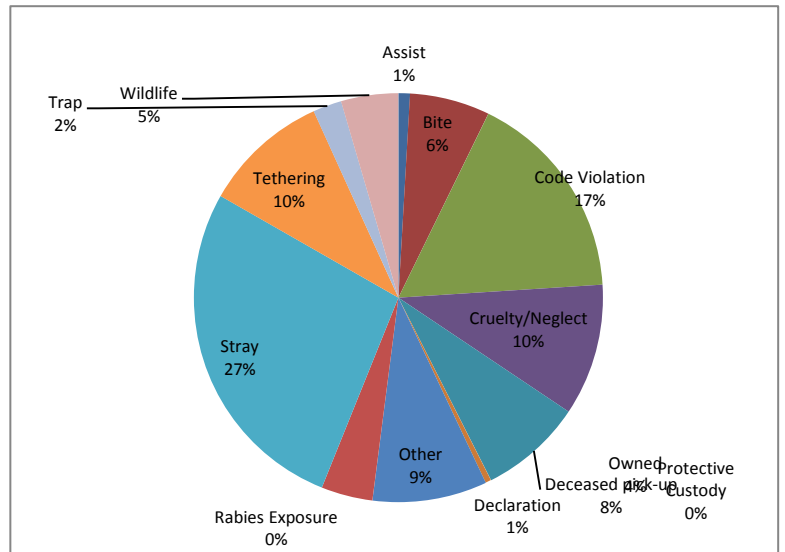

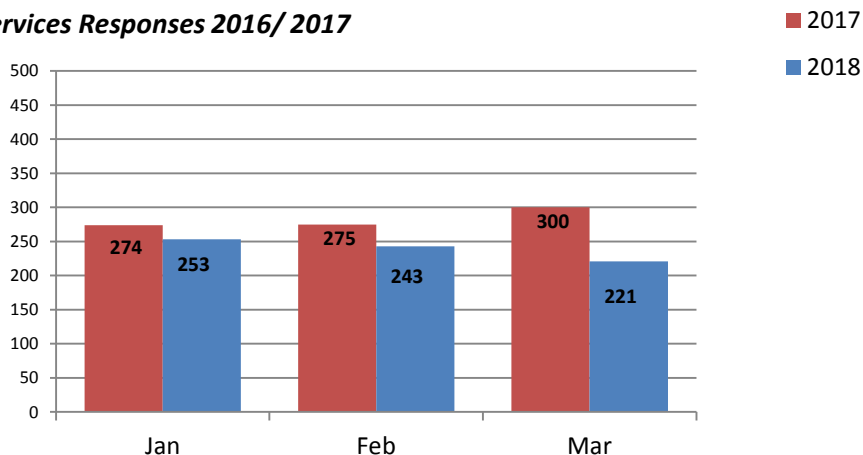

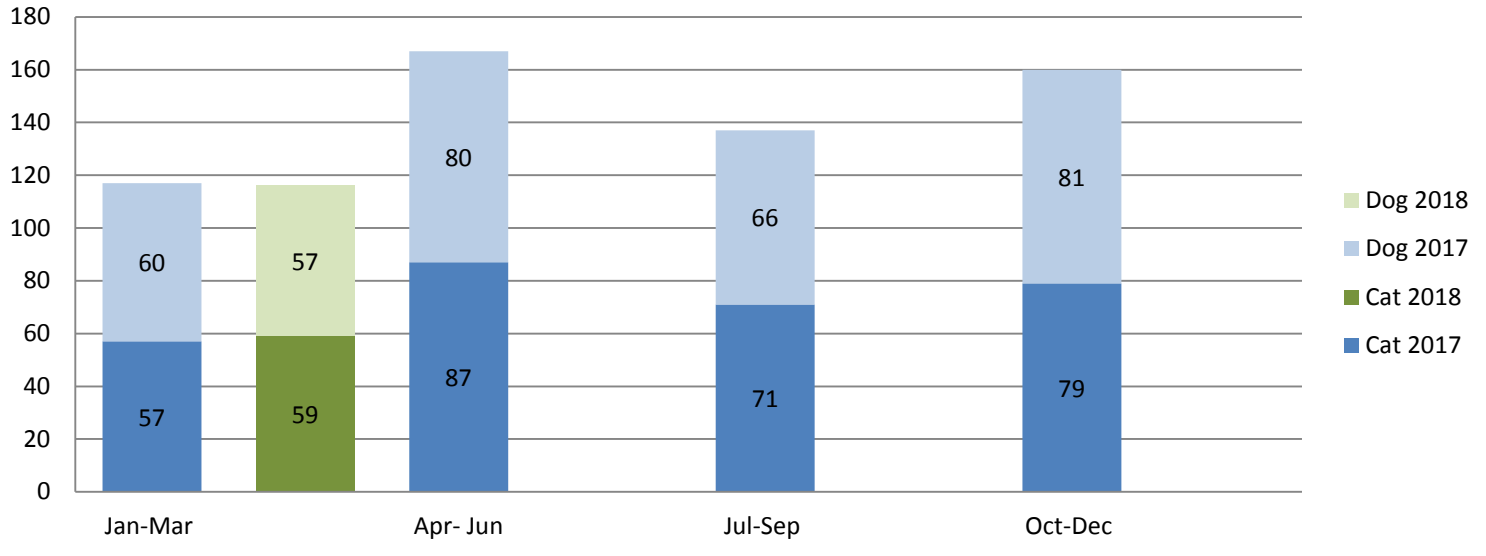


Monthly Field Services Responses 2016/ 2017
