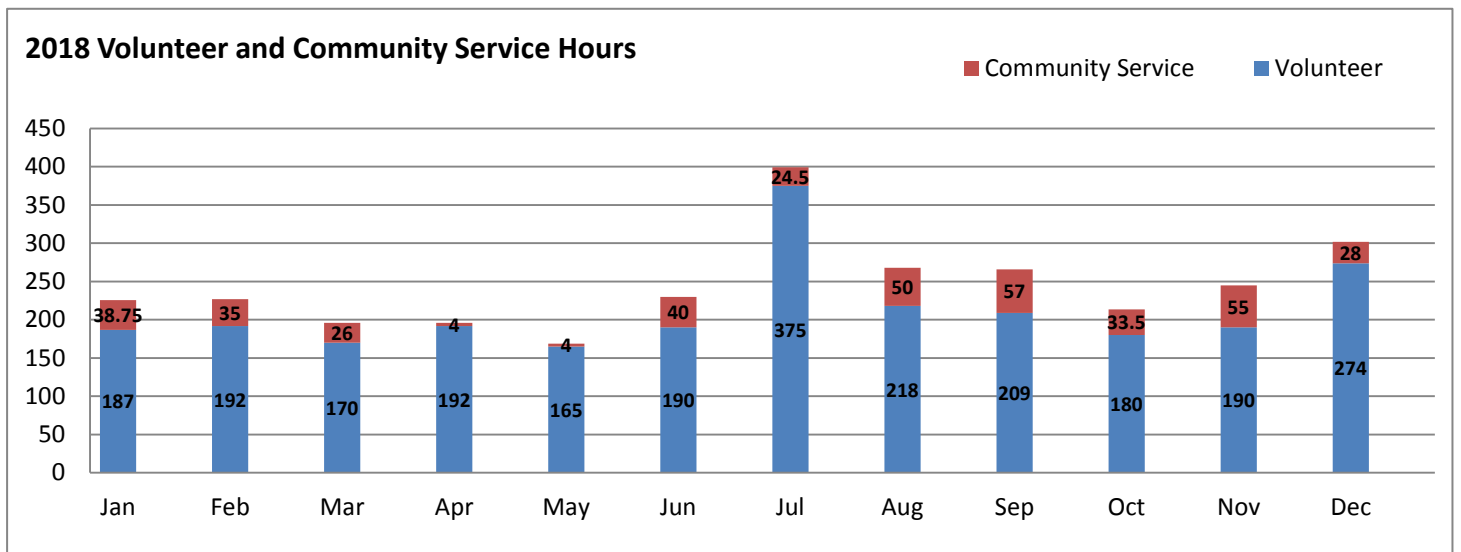
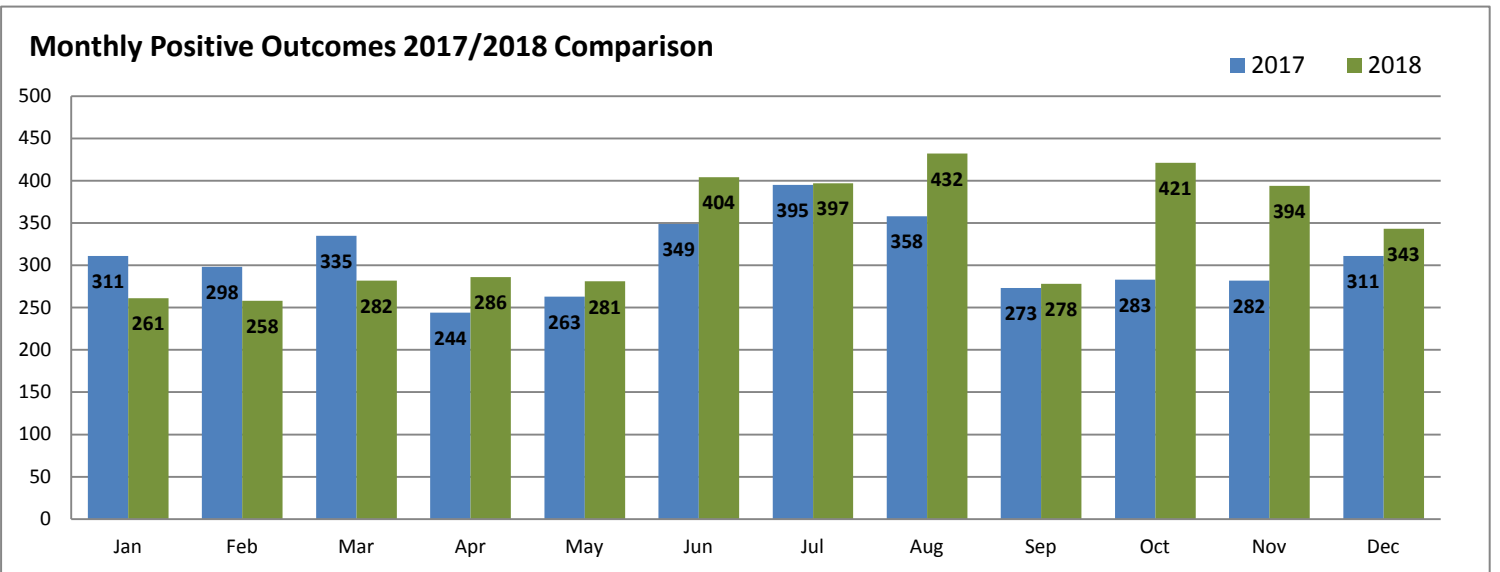
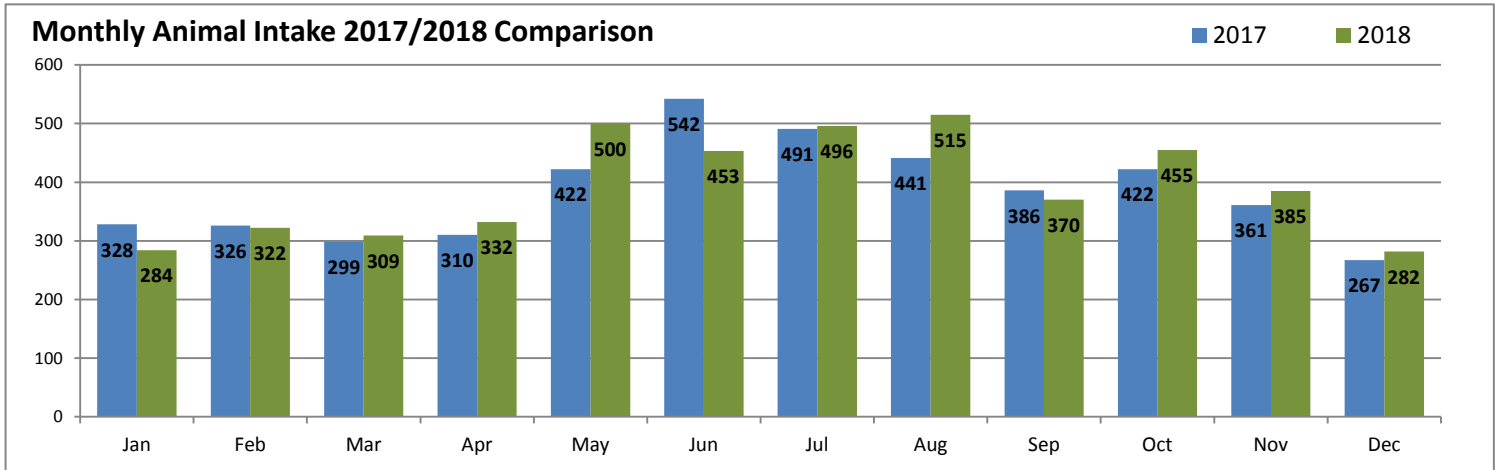
Shelter Euthanasia Reasons

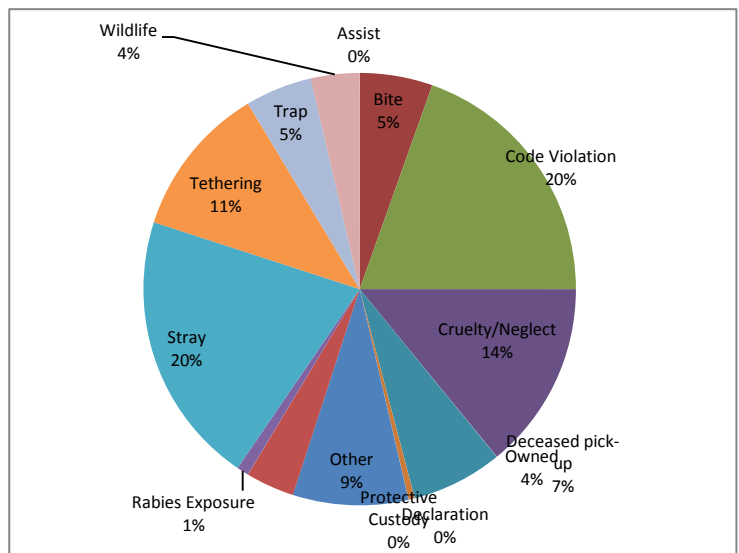

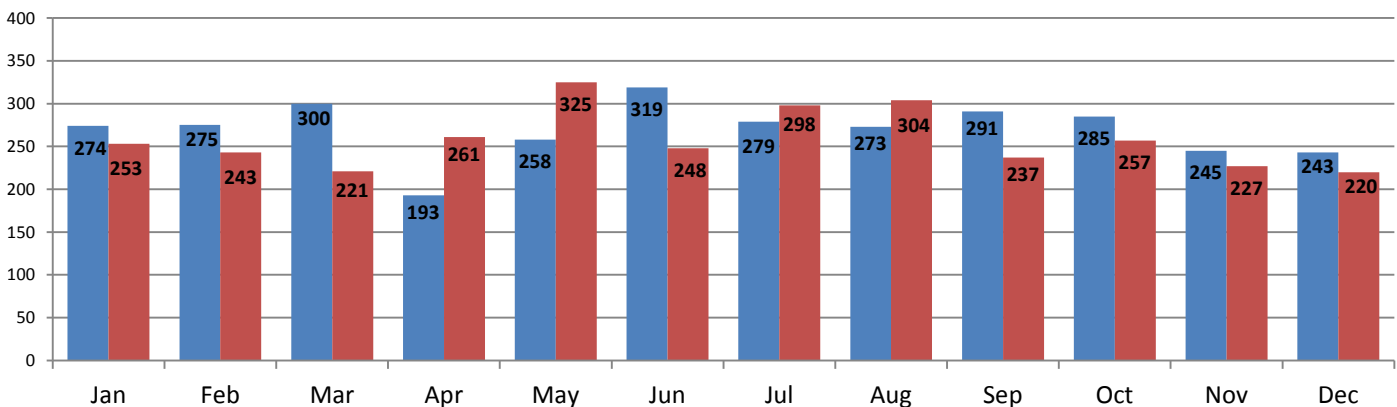

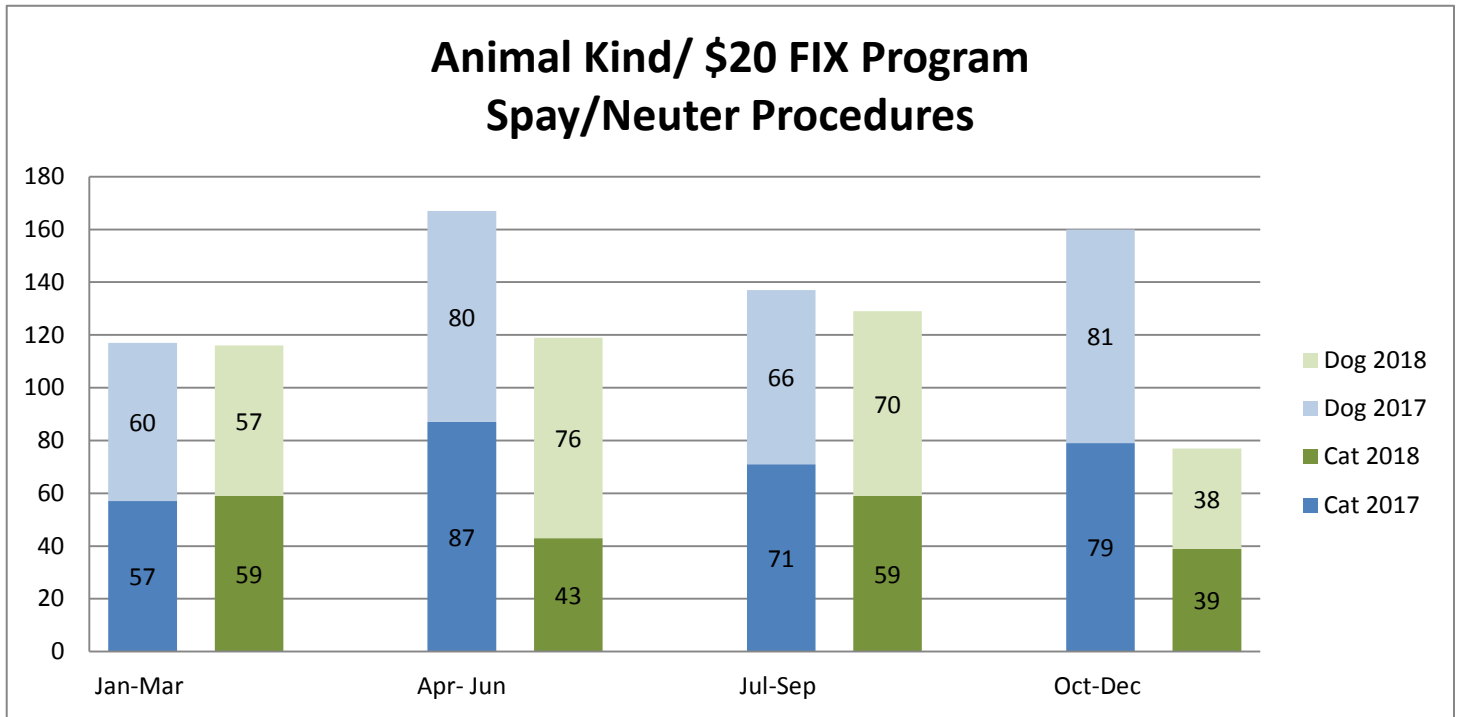


Monthly Field Services Responses 2017/ 2018
