## **Sand Filter Operation and Maintenance Agreement**

I will keep a maintenance record on this Stormwater Control Measure (SCM). This maintenance record will be kept in a log in a known set location. Any deficient SCM elements noted in the inspection will be corrected, repaired or replaced immediately. These deficiencies can affect the integrity of structures, safety of the public, and the removal efficiency of the SCM.

Important maintenance procedures:

- The drainage area will be carefully managed to reduce the sediment load to the sand filter.
- The sedimentation chamber or forebay will be cleaned out whenever sediment depth exceeds six inches.
- Once a year, sand media will be skimmed.
- The sand filter media will be replaced whenever it fails to function properly after maintenance.

The sand filter will be inspected quarterly and within 24 hours after every storm event greater than 1.0 inches. Records of operation and maintenance will be kept in a known set location and will be available upon request. Annually, by May 31, an inspection shall be completed by a qualified professional and submitted to the City of Burlington.

Inspection activities shall be performed as follows. Any problems that are found shall be repaired immediately.
