

RE-ADVERTISEMENT FOR PROPOSALS

CDBG RUBY LANE WALKING TRAIL CONNECTION

Sealed proposals will be received by the City of Burlington, N. C., in the Conference Room of the Engineering Department, located at 425 S. Lexington Avenue, Burlington, NC 27215, until **2:00 p.m., Tuesday, March 22, 2022** for the above listed contract as shown in the plans and described in the Special Conditions.

Each proposal must be made on the blank forms provided in the bound copies of "SPECIFICATIONS AND PROPOSAL FOR CONTRACT #2022-019 CDBG RUBY LANE WALKING TRAIL CONNECTION" and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope and addressed to City Engineer, Engineering Department, 425 S. Lexington Avenue, Burlington, NC. The name, address and license number of the bidder must be plainly written on the outside of the envelope, and the envelope marked plainly with the contract name and number.

No Bid Bond shall be required for the submission of a proposal to the City of Burlington.

Withdrawal of any proposal not in compliance or as allowed within the terms and specifications herein shall cause future submissions to the City of Burlington to be considered non-responsive and non-competitive and be rejected with cause.

A separate Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in an amount equal to one hundred per cent (100%) of the contract price will be required, using the enclosed forms.

The City reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids or to award such contract as in its judgment is deemed to be the best interest of the City.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Pending the weather, a brief onsite pre-bid meeting and project walk will be held at **3:30pm, Tuesday, March 15, 2022**. City of Burlington engineering personnel will review bid requirements, be available to walk the project, and answer pertinent questions.

The contract to be awarded for the proposed work may be extended up to fifty (50%) percent of the contract price without consent and permission of the contractor, and an additional fifty (50%) with the consent and permission of the contractor. This extension may be outside the project limits, at the discretion of the City Engineer. All extensions shall include time extensions as determined by the City Engineer based on the dollar amount of the extension in relationship to the original Contract time. Total extensions not to exceed one hundred (100%) percent of the contract price.

All contractors are hereby notified that they shall be properly licensed under North Carolina State Laws governing their respective trades.
