All Athletic and SilverArts Registrations are Due February 27, 2023 at 5pm

- OPEN TO:** All Alamance County residents, as well as, any resident of the City of Mebane, who have lived in North Carolina at least three consecutive months and are 50 years of age or older. Age on December 31, 2023 will determine the category in which the athlete will compete. In athletics, participants will compete against others of their own sex and age as follows: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, etc. **Proof of age must be presented at registration. IN DOUBLES, TEAMS WILL BE PLACED IN AGE CATEGORIES BY THE AGE OF THE YOUNGEST PLAYER.**
- EVENTS:** Are listed on registration form. If 2 events overlap or are scheduled at the same time, the athlete will need to choose the event he/she wants. In SilverArts, each **artist may enter up to three pieces** in any combination of categories. However, if total entries exceed available display space, only one or two pieces per person will be displayed. **A/BSG reserves the right to choose pieces to be displayed if there are too many entries for the available space.**
- EQUIPMENT:** Participants in the following events will supply their own equipment: Golf - USGA approved golf clubs and balls; Tennis - tennis racket and balls; Horseshoes - horseshoes (optional); Cycling - bicycle and helmet; Pickleball – racquet; badminton- racket.
- ENTRY FEE:** As a participant in the 36th Annual *Alamance/Burlington Senior Games* your entry fee of \$10 will include an official Senior Games shirt and a Senior Games packet of information. A facility fee of \$17.00 will be charged for golf, \$9 for each bowling event, \$9 for billiards and \$5 for Putt-Putt (for each practice round and tournament play). These are in addition to the \$10.00 entry fee. If registration form is accepted after deadline you are not guaranteed a shirt. **Entry fees will be refunded if registration is cancelled by March 10 for both athletic competitions and SilverArts. ATHLETIC AND SILVERARTS REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN UNTIL FEBRUARY 27 AT 5PM. SilverArts participants will be required to sign a liability waiver release form releasing A/BSG from damage or theft that may occur while artwork is displayed.**
- AWARDS:** Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals will be awarded to the top three finalists in each age/sex category in each athletic event. Athletic medals will be given out at the Senior Games Bash on May 12. Ribbons will be awarded to SilverArts winners. Each sub-category will be judged separately except for Performing Arts. Awards for Performing Arts will be available at the conclusion of the talent show. State Finals Registration Forms will be available at the Kernodle Senior Center. All local games participants who complete their athletic event(s) and score, qualify for State Finals (no score is necessary for tournament or team sports). Qualifications for State Final SilverArts remains the same: Performing - best in show, Heritage and Visual - best in show and places 1-3, Literary - places 1-2. **DEADLINE TO REGISTER FOR STATE FINALS: EARLY BIRD DEADLINE JULY 1, OR MUST BE RECEIVED BY NCSG BY 5:00 PM ON AUGUST 1.**

FINAL CONFIRMATIONS WILL BE SENT BY MARCH 23, 2023.

Best of Show winners in Performing Arts and Best in Show and 1st Place winners in Literary Arts are eligible for State Finals. 1st Place, 2nd Place and 3rd Place winners in each subcategory of Visual and Heritage Arts are eligible for State Finals. An artist may only submit one entry per subcategory to State Finals. Winners should plan on carrying their entries to State Finals.
